To establish a premier, fully NARHA certified Northern Illinois and Southern Wisconsin equestrian related riding program and center serving children and adults with a variety of physical and mental disabilities.

## ***Mission***

To provide individuals with physical, mental and emotional challenges alternative therapeutic programs using quality trained horses. By providing quality trained horses each rider will have a chance to experience the highest quality ride with maximum benefits.

## ***Why Therapeutic Horseback Riding?***

By partnering rider, horse, volunteer and community we offer riding opportunities that challenge disabled riders to achieve their maximum potential which rewards their efforts.

Physically, horseback riding gently and rhythmically moves the body in a manner which is similar to the walking gait of a human. The horse's complex series of movements uses all body muscles of the rider. Riders experience increased strength, balance and muscle control.

Mentally, horseback riding increases concentration, patience and discipline. It improves sequential thought processing, increases the riders' ability to communicate emotions and develops spatial awareness.

Emotionally, the unique relationship formed with a horse can help improve interpersonal relationships. It provides the opportunity for the rider to bond with the instructor, volunteer and the horse which in turn develops trust. We provide a non-competitive environment for learning new abilities, self-discipline and improved concentration which builds self-confidence, self-esteem and coping skills.

Socially, horseback riding nurtures a positive self-image. Disabled riders often experience independence for the first time in their lives. They also develop an awareness of being part of a team. All riders have the ability to learn new skills and participate in a recognized sport.
